Water Well Permit Restrictions and Terms

- 1. Water well permits are required prior to commencing construction. If construction of a water well is commended prior to obtaining a permit, a late permit must be obtained from the district along with a \$500.00 application fee.
- 2. New wells must comply with Neb. Rev. Stat. §46-609 and §46-651 in addition to the District's spacing requirements. No new regulated well except a backup well shall be constructed upon any land in this District within one thousand three hundred and twenty (1,320) feet of any other regulated well, regardless of ownership. Any replacement irrigation water well that replaces irrigation water well drilled after January 1, 2008 must be constructed within one thousand three hundred and twenty (1,320) feet of the well that is being replaced.
- 3. This permit does not register the water well with the Nebraska Department of Water Resources. All water wells are required to be registered with the Nebraska Department of Water Resources within 30 days after the water well is completed.
- 4. A replacement water well is one which replaced an abandoned water well that has been operated within the last three years, and is constructed to water the same tract of land as the abandoned water well which is being replaced. As of February 3, 1997, replacement wells **DO** need a permit from the Upper Loup Natural Resources District.
- 5. If a water well is being replaced, it must be properly abandoned according to state guidelines. A copy of these guidelines are available from the Upper Loup Natural Resources District.
- 6. If the water well is not constructed and equipped within a one year period from the date of approval, a new water well permit is needed.
- 7. Water wells may not be drilled within 50 feet of a stream bank without first getting a surface water right for that stream from the Nebraska Department of Water Resources pursuant to Neb. Stat. §46-637.
- 8. Any person who, on or after February 3, 1997, commences or causes construction of such a water well for which the required permit has not been obtained, or who knowingly furnishes false information regarding such permit, shall be guilty of a Class IV misdemeanor pursuant to Neb. Stat. §46-602.01 and §46-613.02.
- 9. Permits are not required for test holes, temporarily dewatering wells with an intended use of less than 90 days, or water wells designed and constructed to pump (yield) 50 gallons per minute or less.
- 10. The issuance by the District of this permit or registration of a water well by the Director of the Nebraska Department of Water Resources pursuant to Neb. Stat. §46-602 shall not vest in any person the right to violate any rule, regulation, or control in effect on the date of issuance of the permit or the registration of the water well or to violate any rule, regulation, or control properly adopted after such date.
